**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MORATORIUM ON OUTDOOR FIRES EXCEPT FOR BARBECUES WITHIN THE CITY OF PHOENIX, OREGON UNTIL THE FIRE DANGER DROPS BELOW LEVEL HIGH**

WHEREAS, The City of Phoenix recognizes that Southern Oregon has been in drought conditions for the last couple of years; and

WHEREAS, the vegetation in and around Phoenix is more combustible in drought conditions than during a normal weather year; and


WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix wishes to improve the safety of its citizens by helping prevent fires;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PHOENIX RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS, the City Council of the City of Phoenix, Oregon, does hereby enact a moratorium on outdoor fires except for barbeques within the City of Phoenix, Oregon until the fire danger drops below level high.
