A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A COOPERATIVE IMPROVEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PHOENIX AND OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FERN VALLEY INTERCHANGE LANDSCAPE

WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix has agreed in the past to take a position of financially assisting in rebuilding the Fern Valley Interchange; and

WHEREAS, the City of realizes that having a positive working relationship with the Oregon Department of Transportation is critical in the growth and future of Phoenix; and

WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix appreciates Oregon Department of Transportation's willingness to work with the City and delay payment; and


WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix believes that it should help contribute to the beautification of the roadway coming into its City Center; and
