**ORDINANCE NO. 996**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PHOENIX REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 911 AND  
VACATING PHOENIX MUNICIPAL CODE 2.14; AND PROVIDING FOR AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Phoenix enacted Ordinance No. 911 on February 2, 2009, which created the City of Phoenix Economic Development Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to repeal the City's code to eliminate the Economic Development Council and to repeal the above-referenced ordinance that created the Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PHOENIX ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Findings:** The City Council hereby repeals the existing Economic Development Council Ordinance No. 911 and vacates the Phoenix Municipal Code 2.14.

**Section 2. Severability:** If any section or portion of a section of this Ordinance proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or part of a section of this Ordinance.

**Section 3. Effective Date:** This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its date of adoption.
