The changes are being made to address route concerns and to minimize truck traffic in specific neighborhoods. ## Bear Creek Greenway Slurry Seal Project



Jackson County Roads & Parks has completed their slurry seal project along the greenway trail in Phoenix. Slurry seal is a type of surface treatment used to maintain and extend the life of asphalt pavements like that on the Bear Creek Greenway Trail. In addition to extended payment life, slurry seal also lowers the long-term maintenance and repair costs while giving the pavement a fresh, uniform appearance and enhancing the aesthetic appeal. The project was funded through the Joint Powers partnership and the final product turned out great. Thank you Jackson County Roads & Parks and the Joint Powers Partnership.
